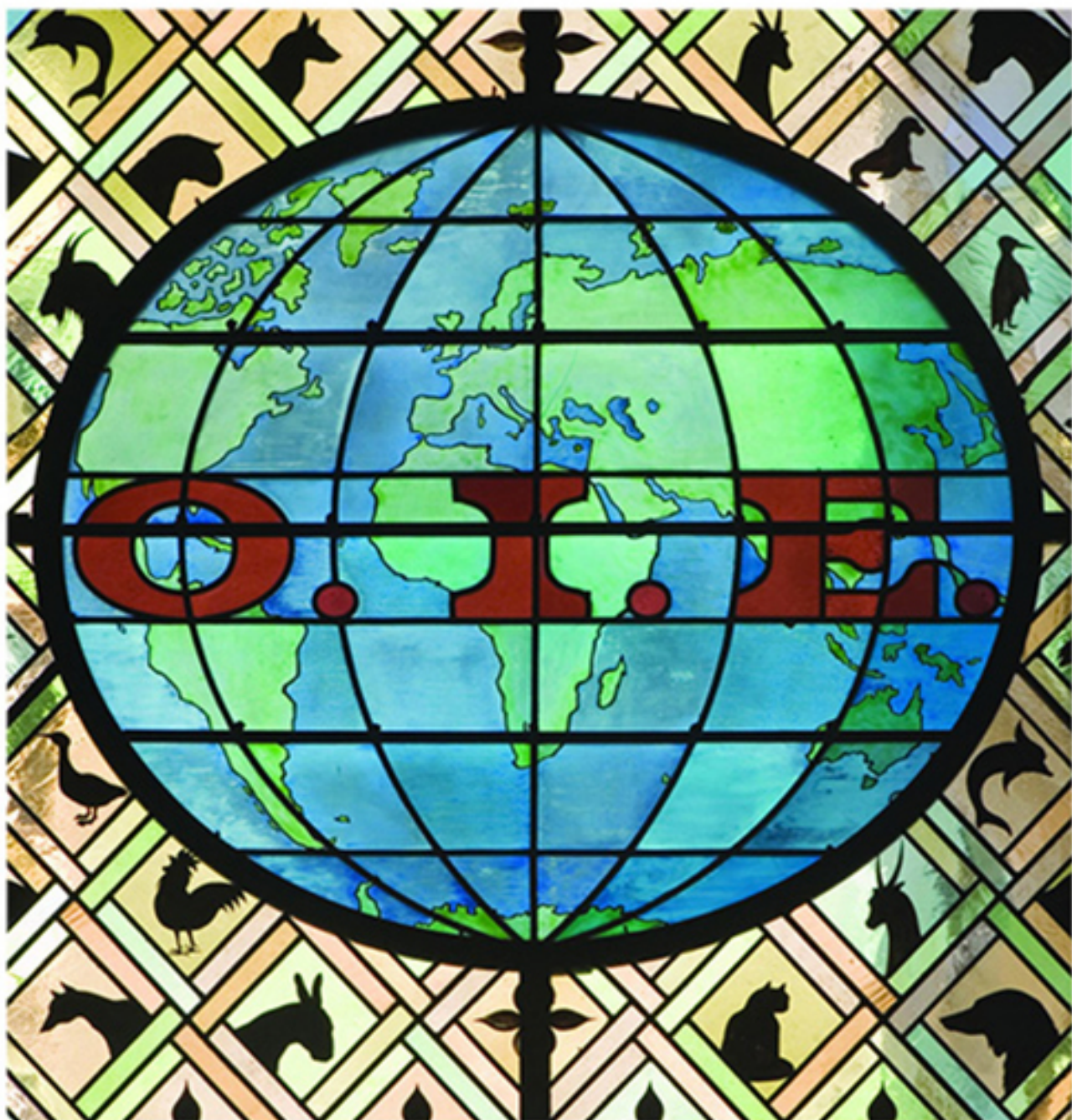

ANIMAL HEALTH

The Delegate of Colombia to the OIE submitted a dossier to the Director General of the OIE, requesting the recovery of the official disease status of the ‘foot and mouth disease (FMD)-free zone where vaccination is practised’ in Colombia, which had been recognised by the OIE World Assembly of Delegates ([Resolution No. 22 of May 2017](#)) and had been suspended with effect from 10 August 2018.

The [OIE Scientific Commission for Animal Diseases](#) considered the information provided by the Delegate of Colombia and concluded that this zone in Colombia fulfils the requirements of [the relevant provisions of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code Article 8.8.7](#), to fully regain its ‘FMD-free zone where vaccination is practised’ status, with effect from 5 February 2020. The regained status was recognised by the World Assembly of OIE Delegates in [Resolution No. 7 of June 2020](#).
