I am always available if any OIE colleagues need tips on how to take care of lizards, snakes or tortoises 😊.

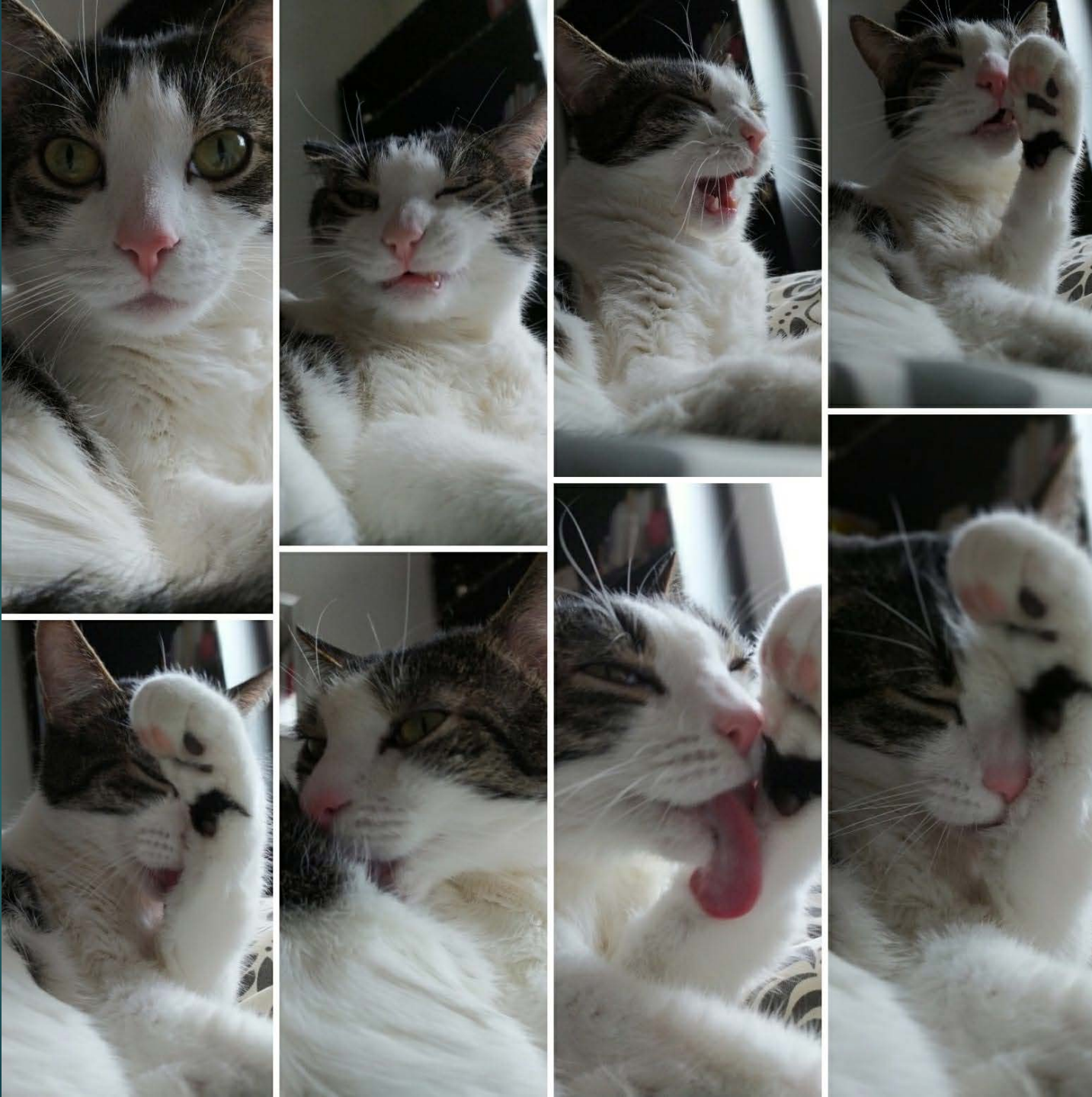
