Dear colleagues,

I am pleased to inform you that the DAC Working Party on Development Finance Statistics has approved inclusion of the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) on its List of ODA-Eligible International Organisations with an ODA coefficient of 61%.

As such, it has been agreed that this 61% coefficient will apply to core contributions to the OIE Regular Budget, for reporting these as multilateral ODA.

It was further agreed that this 61% coefficient could be applied to voluntary contributions to the OIE World Animal Health and Welfare Fund (OIE World Fund) - which are not earmarked for a specific country or region - in order to report an estimated share that will benefit countries on the DAC List of ODA Recipients as bilateral ODA.

In addition, contributions to the OIE World Fund can be reported in full as bilateral ODA if they are earmarked for countries on the DAC List of ODA Recipients.
