

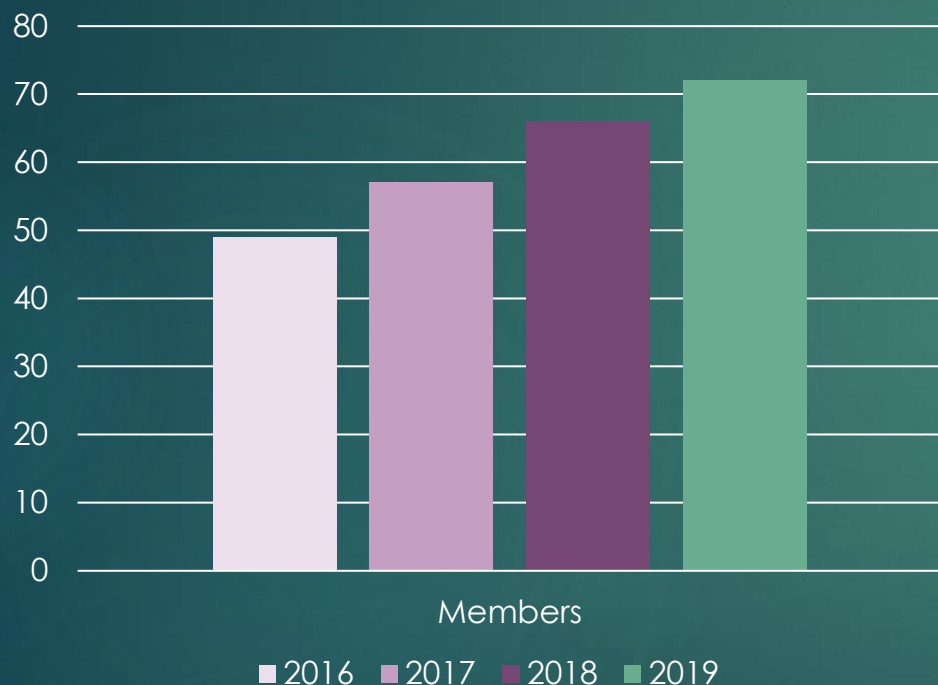

2020 ACCOUNTS



Membership 2020



- ▶ 4 members
 - ▶ Membership fees were not actively sought
 - ▶ 2020 members were offered the opportunity to pass over their membership to 2021
- ▶ Fees for 2020 (same as the year before)
 - ▶ Interns – 5€, Staff – 30€, Head of Unit – 40€, Head of Department and above – 55€
- ▶ Membership fees collected in 2020 = 140€, but this will carry over to 2021

Budget 2020

▶ Credit

- ▶ Members' contribution = N/A
- ▶ OIE's contribution = N/A
- ▶ Reimbursement from Rungis activity (2019) = 753 €
- ▶ Banking fees = 114 €

▶ Debit

- ▶ Insurance for 2020 = 382 €

Balance 2020*

▶ Starting balance	(31/01/2020)	2437.29 €
▶ End balance	(31/12/2020)	2994.89 €
▶ Current balance	(23/02/2021)	2527.91 € 240 € in petty cash

Belev Fund 2020

The Belev Fund was created by generous donations from the late Dr Belev to honour the memory of his son Tony who passed away prematurely

Its purpose was to improve the socio-cultural life of the children of the Amicale members. In recent years, this Fund has been used to buy Christmas gifts for the children of OIE staff and to fund other activities for children (unfortunately this was not possible for 2020)

Funds available = 24,418.60 €

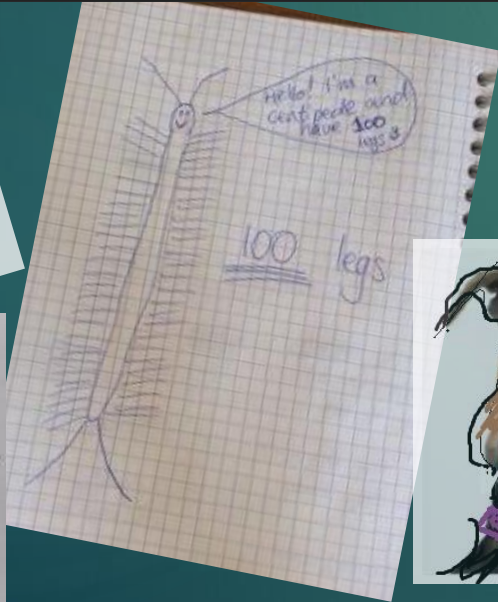
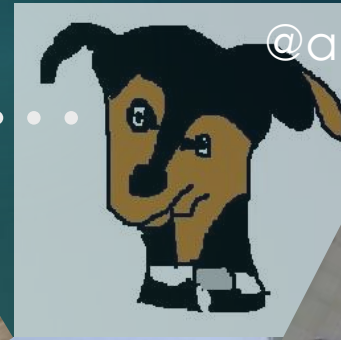
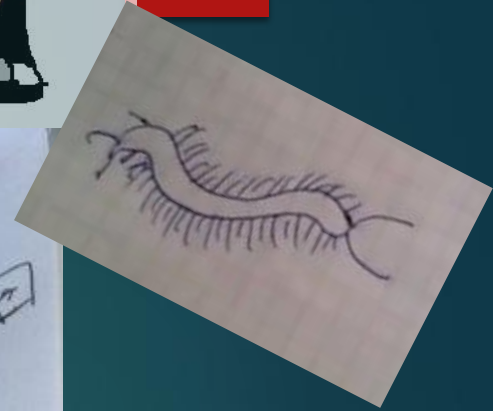
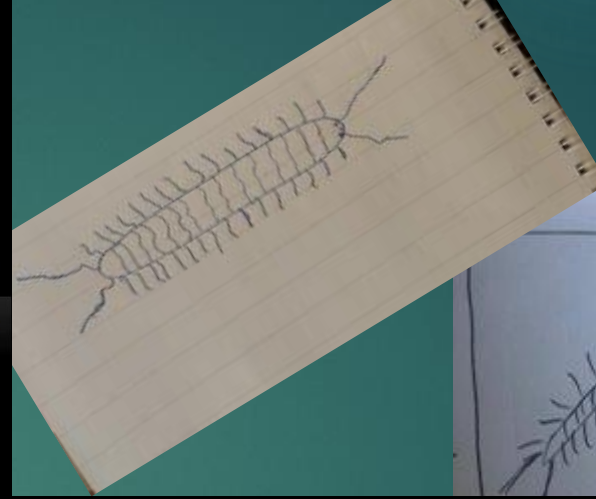


Conclusion of the financial discussion

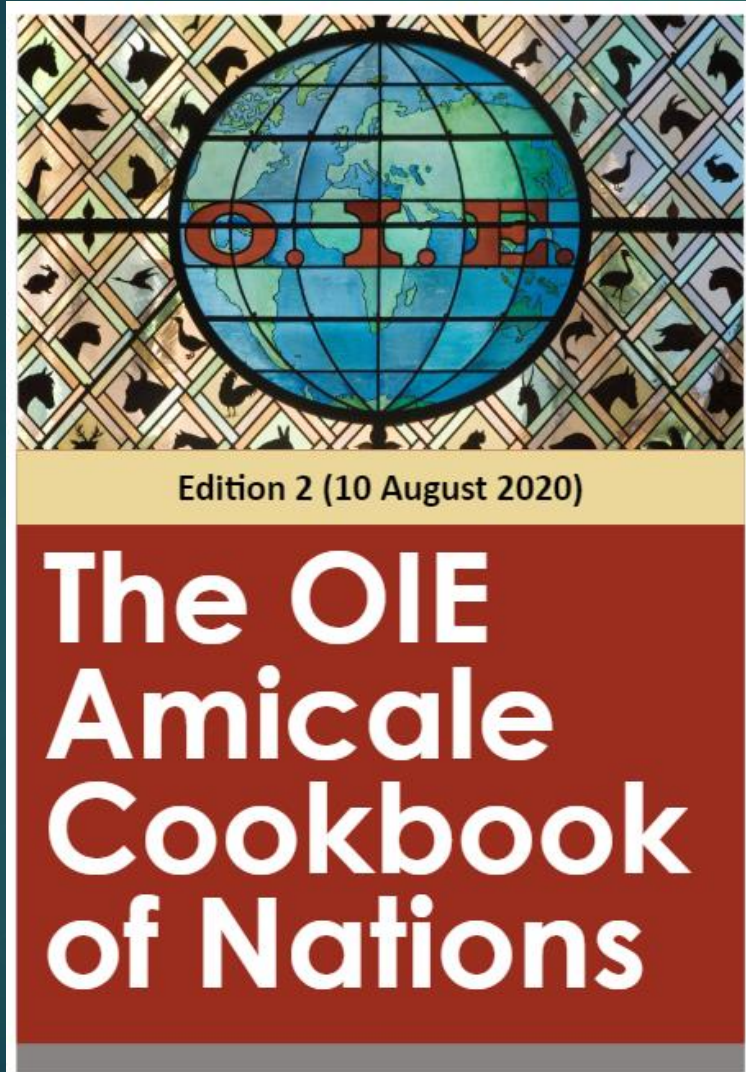
- ▶ Positive balance for 2020, but this is largely due to reimbursement for a 2019 activity

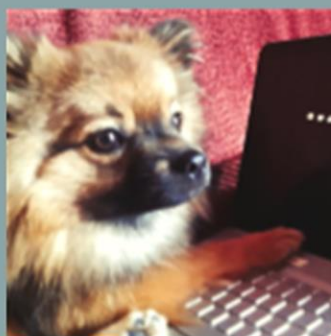
